Brilliant Term at Beccles High School

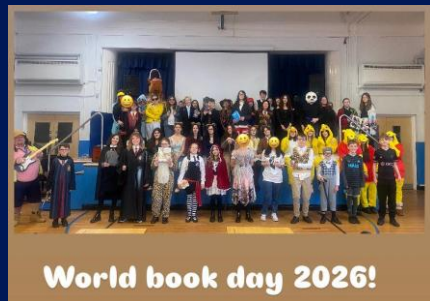
It has been another fantastic and action-packed term here at Beccles High School. Students have shown exceptional effort, resilience and participation across all areas of school life.

Our new Music Club launched this term, providing a creative space for students twice a week.

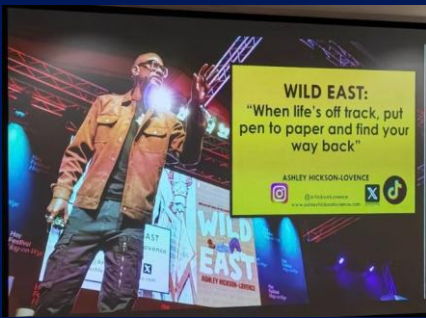
Science Sparks
