Re: Changes from September 2024

Please find within this letter numerous updates relating to the school from September 2024. Please take the time to read through these details, and should you have any questions or queries, you can contact us using beccles@seckfordeducation.org.uk

As you will be aware, SET Beccles School have been working in partnership with Sapientia Education Trust for close to 18 months. In September 2024, SET Beccles School will formally become part of the Sapientia Education Trust's family of schools across Norfolk and Suffolk.

As part of the move from Seckford to Sapientia, the school's current name, 'SET Beccles School' will change to 'Beccles High School' from September 2024. This is a key part of the rebranding of our school; the logos, marketing and branding associated with the Seckford Education Trust will cease at the end of this academic year on 19 July 2024 and be replaced for September.

School Uniform Policy

From September 2024 we will also be introducing a new school uniform as part of our transfer into the Sapientia Education Trust. We have taken this opportunity to review the branded items required for our school uniform. We recognise that this presents a cost to parents initially for a new tie and jumper. However, we feel that the costs over time will be reduced due to the removal of the school blazer.

Beccles High School requires all students to wear a school uniform. Our school uniform helps our pupils to feel part of our school community and new items have been chosen to be comfortable and appropriate for the activities pupils will undertake during the school day, as well as being more affordable than the traditional blazer pupils wear at present.

Government guidance on the cost of school uniforms

In the Autumn of 2021, the government issued new guidance to schools on uniform. The aim of this guidance was to minimise the cost of uniform for parents through a reduction in school branded items, allowing parents to purchase uniform from a wider range of suppliers.

Beccles High School and Sapientia Education Trust fully support making school uniform affordable and accessible for all children, and we have reviewed and changed our school uniform to reflect the requirements outlined in the statutory guidance.

School uniform requirements

Branded Items

From September 2024 we will reduce the number of branded school uniform items required. These branded items will now also be available from multiple suppliers allowing parents to choose the most convenient and cost-effective solution for their needs.

To that end, we will be phasing out our blazer. During this transition year, students can either wear the new branded jumper, or can continue to wear their blazer with a stitched badge that we will provide free of charge.

If you are struggling to access any item of uniform during the school year, please contact the school office for guidance and support.

Uniform Open Evening

On Wednesday 10 July, we will be hosting an open event for parents and students to come and see the new uniform, to check sizing and to receive full information on uniform requirements and how to order. We welcome parents and students from 3:30 – 6pm. We look forward to seeing you there.

It still important that uniform policy is followed to provide a shared identity for all pupils in our school. Our behaviour policy provides further details of the systems and sanctions regarding uniform compliance.
